2. Accept the verbal resignation of Chastity Steward, Custodian, effective July 31, 2026
3. Consider the cancellation of the Boards' meeting scheduled for Tuesday, August 11, 2026
4. Concur with the appointment of Wesley Sturgill to the position of Social Services Worker 2 within the PCSA Unit of the Ashland County Department of Job & Family Services, a bargaining unit position with a starting wage rate of \$23.90 per hour, to be effective August 17, 2026, as recommended by Peter Stefaniuk, Director
5. Authorize the appointment of Rosette Bennett to the position of Clerical Specialist 2 within the Income Maintenance Unit of the Ashland County Department of Job & Family Services, a bargaining unit position with a starting wage rate of \$15.84 per hour, to be effective August 17, 2026, as recommended by Peter Stefaniuk, Director
