1. Approve the minutes of the Boards' meeting of Thursday, July 9, 2026
2. Approve the minutes of the Boards' meeting of Thursday, July 16, 2026
3. Concur with the appointment of Mark J. Keck to the position of Social Services Supervisor 1 within the PCSA Unit of the Ashland County Department of Job & Family Services, a non-bargaining unit position with a starting wage rate of \$36.73 per hour, to be effective July 27, 2026, as requested by Peter Stefaniuk, Director
4. Consider the cancellation of the Boards' meeting scheduled for Tuesday, July 28, 2026
5. Approve and enter into a one-year contract with Dr. Dale Thomae to provide jail inmate physician services at the rate of \$3,333.33 per month, to be paid for from Fund #305, Jail Operations, as requested by Sheriff Schneider
