1. Approve the minutes of the Boards' meeting of Thursday, July 24, 2025

2. Concur with the following appropriations:

Health Dept.- \$2,445.00 to Fund #9, #8010 transfers out
 -to correct a 2023 pay-in that should have been credited to the sheriff's office

Commissioners- \$500,000.00 to Fund #1, dept. #35, commissioners other, #8010 transfers out
 -to allow for a transfer to the Capital Projects fund

5. Authorize a Subdivision Participation and Release Form in order to allow Ashland County to participate in the Purdue Direct Opioid Settlement

6. Authorize the re-appointment of Robert DeSanto as Ashland County's representative on the Natural Resource Assistance Council, District 16, for a three-year term from October 12, 2025 until October 11, 2028

7. Accept an estimate in the amount of \$1,414.94 from W. W. Williams for generator repairs at the jail, to be paid for from Fund #305, Jail Operations, as recommended by Nick Lamp, Maintenance Superintendent
8. Authorize an agreement with the Richland County Commissioners for the purchase and sharing of portable covert camera systems for law enforcement purposes
9. Approve and enter into a one year contract with Dr. Dale Thomae to provide jail inmate physician services at the rate of \$3,333.33 per month, to be paid for from Fund #305, Jail Operations, as requested by Sheriff Schneider
10. Accept an estimate from Sloan Concrete in the amount of \$35,628.00 to remove and replace sidewalks at the sheriff's office, to be paid for from Fund #305, Jail Operations
11. Approve and enter into a road maintenance agreement with the City of Ashland for approximately 2,214 feet of road in Milton Township, as requested by Edward Meixner, Engineer
